Our ending bank balance on February 28, 2022, was \$69,782.77. We have two outstanding items totaling \$7,197.42 (cattle handling and rifle prizes) which will bring our bank balance as of 2/28/22 to \$62,585.35. After all our scholarship obligations pay out, our unrestricted cash amount will be \$54,119.35.

Matagorda Show Recap:

There were 59 entries shown by 18 kids. Great group of kids and a nice starter show.

Cattle Baron Sale:

Everything is in place. Julie Pack will be our veterinarian. Rick has pen signs made. There will be a raffle and Rick will have the tickets with him. There will also be a silent auction. We still need a person to set up cow patty bingo.We also need someone to walk the pens on Sunday to make sure no cattle are left behind. The rifles are currently in Rick's hands.

Winchester Futurity:

We need volunteers to work the ring during the futurity, with Steven M. and Stephen Head. We need a runner for score sheets (Kathy L.) and a person to sell raffle tickets. Also, there is a need for cow patty bingo observer. We currently have 131 entries.

Scholarship Committee:
