Rules for Consigning and Selling Cattle in the Cattle Baron's Premier Longhorn Sale  
Sale Date: March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022

1. NOMINATION DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 15, 2021
2. All Cattle must be registered in the consignor's name with the TLBAA or ITLA. Calves selling at dam's side must be noted on the dam's transfer application. Calves selling separate (split lot) and yearling heifers need not be registered to the seller if accompanied by a completed registration application.
3. Each lot will be comprised of either: A Cow, Cow/calf pair, Bull or Steer.
  - a. Split lots where the calf is to be sold separate from its dam will be charged \$100 a head plus the additional transfer/registration fee and commission. The cow/calf pair must share the same pen.
4. The Consignment fee is \$350 plus 7% commission.
  - a. \$350 must accompany each nomination application. Make checks payable to TLBGCA
  - b. There is no minimum bid. Failure to sell your animal results in forfeiture of your consignment fee. There is no PO fee.
  - c. Scratched lots will be subject to forfeiture of the consignment fee. Substitutions will be permitted after the consignment deadline; however, the seller is responsible for providing the registration certificate and transfer application to sale management. The seller is advised to bring substitution sheets to be available for buyers with picture, pedigree, breeding info.
5. All nominations must be accompanied with the following
  - a. Consignment form
  - b. Consignment fee \$350 made payable to TLBGCA
  - c. Picture emailed to [brucemccartypromotions@gmail.com](mailto:brucemccartypromotions@gmail.com)
  - d. Original Registration certificate
  - e. Transfer Application- please include breeding and calf information
  - f. AI Certificate if applicable, must be signed by AI breeding technician
6. All cattle must be tested for interstate shipment. Each consignment shall comply with applicable rules and regulations of the Texas Animal Health Commission. Each animal must have health certificate with the following information
  - a. Cow Name, private herd number and lot number
  - b. Negative test results for TB and Brucellosis
  - c. Pregnancy status- open or pregnant
  - d. OCV with tattoo number
  - e. 30 days or less from sale date
  - f. It is consignor's responsibility to deliver health certificate to sale representative (Lee Mathews or Lori McCarty)
  - g. All Heifers 4-12 months of age must have brucellosis vaccine
  - h. All cows must have calf at side or confirmed bred by palpation or blood test and it must be stated on Health Certificate
7. Liability: All persons who attend this sale do so at their own risk. The TLBGCA Cattle Baron Premier Longhorn Sale, their representatives, Bruce McCarty Promotions and anyone else connected with the sale assumes no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accident or loss of life that may occur.
8. All Consignors must comply with all of the above regulations, rules and conditions
9. All nominations will be reviewed by the TLBGCA committee and you will be notified about your acceptance or rejection. Remember we are looking for some of your best cattle, this will enable us to reach our goal of always improving The Cattle Baron Sale by offering quality consignments.
